NOTES AND LEGEND

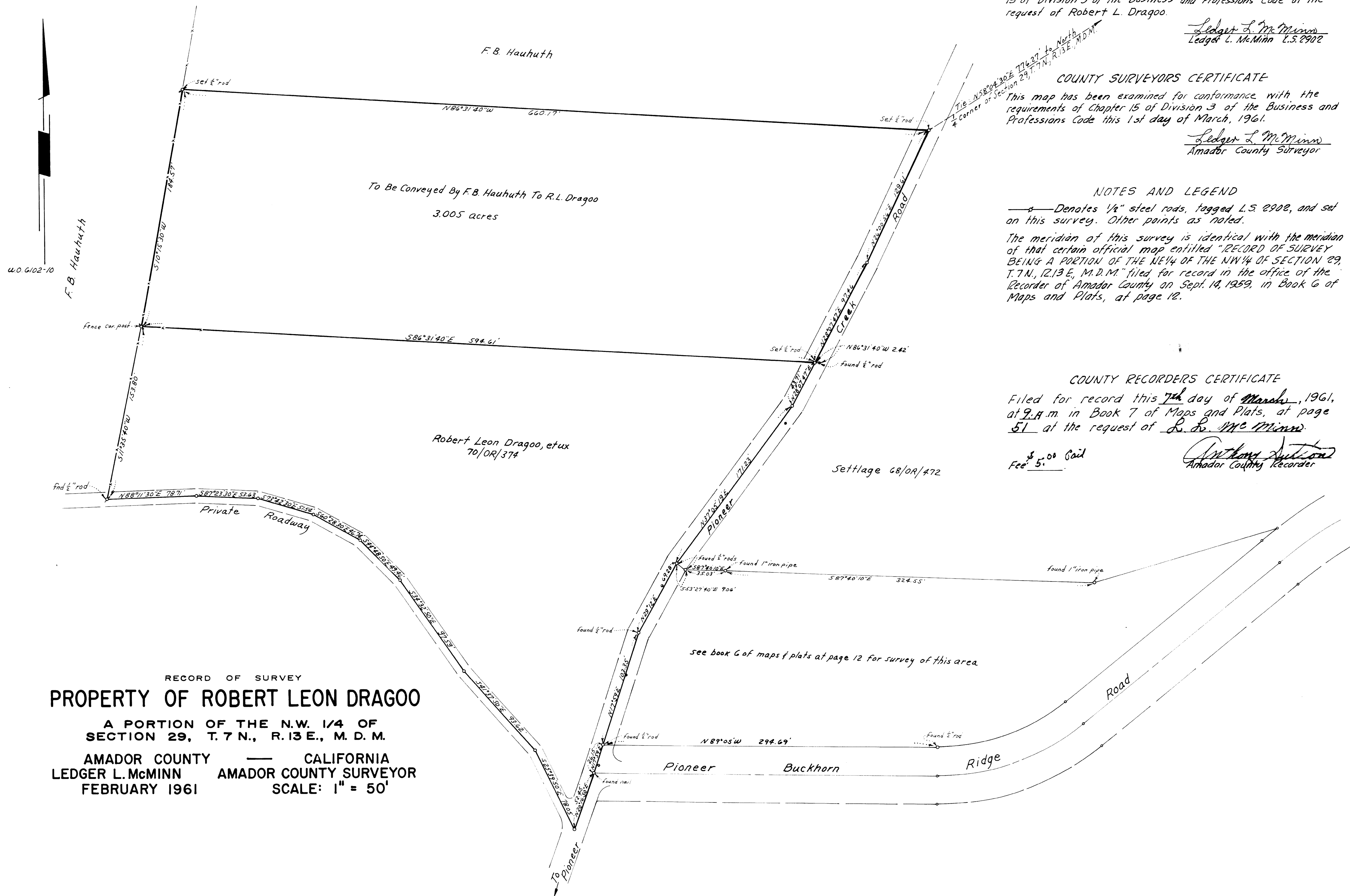
—s— Denotes 1/4" steel rods, tagged L.S. 2902, and set on this survey. Other points as noted.
