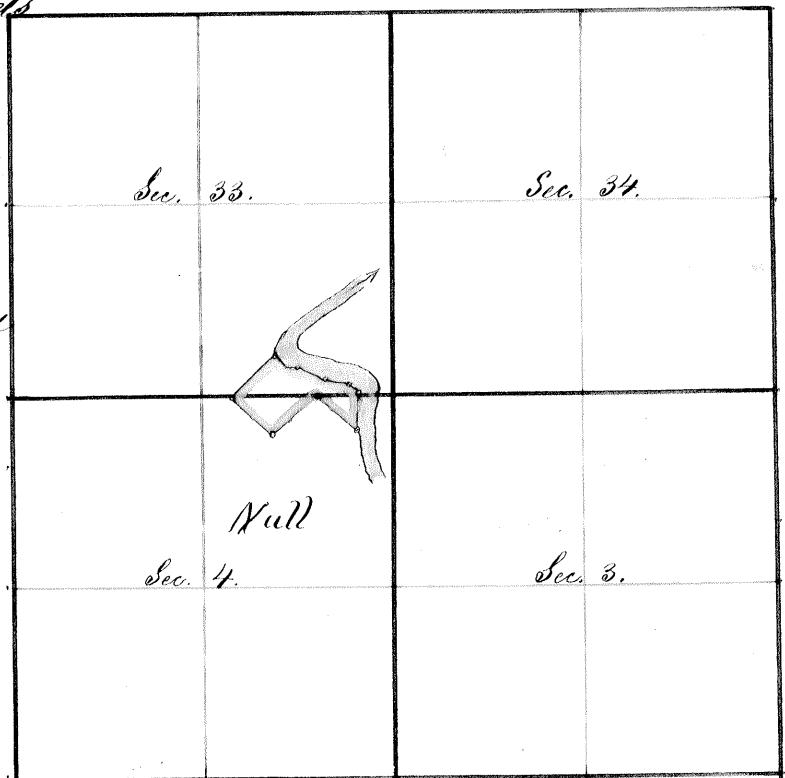

### Field Notes.

Beginning at the U.S. Meander Post on the T<sup>y</sup>. Line between  
Section 33 T<sup>y</sup>. 6 S. and Sec. 4 T<sup>y</sup>. 7 S. Range 9 East of Mt Diablo Base  
and Meridian, thence along the United States Meander Line, the same  
being the Meander line of the "Orestimba Rancho"; - N 46  $\frac{3}{4}$  E 12.67  
chains; to the left bank of the San Joaquin River, thence up stream;  
S 46 E. 3.00 chs, S 82 E 2.50 chs, S 66  $\frac{1}{2}$  E. 6.50 chs, S 73  $\frac{1}{2}$  E. 4.50 chs;  
S 48 E. 2.75 chs, South 8.23 chs. to a Post set at the intersection with  
said Meander Line, thence along said meander line down stream;  
N 49  $\frac{1}{4}$  W 11.30 chs, S. 48  $\frac{1}{2}$  W 12.00 chs, N 46  $\frac{1}{4}$  W 11.75 chs; to the point  
of beginning.

Run by the true Meridian: Magnetic Variation 15° 30' East.  
Surveyed in accordance with the Act of the Legislature  
concerning State Lands, approved April 27th, 1863, and  
the instruction of the Surveyor General.
